In consideration for being permitted to participate in any way in horse riding activities I the undersigned, understand, acknowledge and accept that:

Horse riding and participation in horse related activities is/are dangerous recreational activities and horses and cattle can act in a sudden and unpredictable (changeable) way, especially if frightened or hurt.

There is a significant risk that serious **INJURY** or **DEATH** may result from participating in horse related competition or activities.

I voluntarily **PARTICIPATE** at my **OWN RISK** and assume sole responsibility for any injury, death or property damage I may suffer that arises from my participation in horse related activities.

I understand and acknowledge the dangers associated with the consumption of alcohol or any mind altering drugs before and during the activity and I take full responsibility for any injury, loss or damage associated with their consumption. I agree not to drink alcohol or take drugs prohibited by law before or during any horse activity.

I agree to abide by the Rules & Regulations of the Australian Quarter Horse Association and Central Western Performance Horse Club inc its Affiliated clubs and/or management/organizer of the activities and that I will follow all directions of the management/organizer of the activities. My failure or refusal to do so can result in **my immediate disqualification** from the activities and the forfeiting of all fees paid in relation to the activities. I understand that any such non compliance may result in injury, death and/or permanent disability.

I agree to wear a helmet of the currently approved Australian standard in all activities where the Rules & Regulations governing the activity require the wearing of a helmet, I am solely responsible for ensuring that I wear a suitable helmet correctly when required and take sole responsibility for my actions.

CWPHC SHOW RULES.

- > The CWPHC is an affiliate club of the AAA Ltd and the show is run under AAA Ltd rules. AQHA show & performance rules also apply.
- > Office Hours on show days for entries and membership will be from 8am, unless otherwise advised.
- > Disputes Committee will consist of: T Pearson, M Lewis, S Hicks.
- > All Point recording enquiries will be directed to the Club Point Recorder.
- > **Pre-entry is a requirement for this event** - at the committee's discretion any late entries will incur a \$35 late fee per horse.
- > All entries must be lodged and paid prior to commencement of Show....**NO EXCEPTIONS.**
- > **All stables and camping are being managed by Orange Regional Appaloosa Club. Contact – Debbie Pearson**
- > **Stables and Camping must be pre-booked and pre-paid to secure.**
- > Sawdust is not supplied unless purchased on your stables and camping forms.
- > In the interest of the health and safety of exhibitors and horses, the committee holds the power to cancel or postpone a show if they deem necessary. All Entries and fees will be refunded.
- > Stables will be provided empty. It is the Entrants responsibility to secure their own bedding.
- > A refundable stable bond of \$50.00 must be paid when entering. If the stable is not completely cleaned out 1 hour after last event the deposit will be retained by the club.
- > Camping sites are to be left completely clean. Please take all rubbish and waste with you or put in bins provided. Campsites left in a mess will be charged a site cleaning fee.
- > To be eligible for annual highpoint awards the competitor/horse must compete in a minimum of 50% of the club shows for the season & be a current financial member of CWPHC Inc.
- > This club has a 0% tolerance of bullying and harassment towards our show team and volunteers. Action will be taken against members and competitors if necessary.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. **Entrants/handlers must be a current financial member of the CWPHC Inc. or pay the CWPHC Day Levy fee.**
2. All dogs must be on a lead at all times and are NOT to be in the arena, marshal or spectator areas at any time.
3. Events are to be run under AAA Ltd and AQHA rules and CWPHC rules as specified.
4. **Safety Helmets** – approved safety helmets (Current Aust safety standard) must be worn in all English classes with chin strap securely fastened.
5. **Amateur competitors** must hold a current Amateur Owner Ticket - a copy must be supplied annually.
6. All age classes are as at the age as at 1st August.
7. 2 year old are not to be shown under saddle or in a bridle in hunter in hand or led classes prior to 31st March.
8. All horses present at an AAA Ltd affiliate show must be entered in the show.
9. **BEGINNER RULES:** As per AAA Ltd Rule Book.
10. **Hi Points – Scored as per AAA Ltd rules.**
11. **Any Other Breed Classes** – Horses shown in these classes cannot be shown in other Halter classes or any ridden classes during the show.
12. Competitors/participants at any event run by CWPHC Inc. have a responsibility to ensure the welfare of their horses and at all times to treat their horses humanely and with dignity, respect and compassion. Competitors/participants are to conduct themselves in a professional manner and act with integrity in all dealings with the Affiliate and other competitors, to uphold the rules and regulations of the CWPHC inc. and the respective breed associations at all times.
13. **All youth competing** or taking part in a CWPHC approved event, must have written permission from their parent/guardian to be at that event as a contestant or participant and in the case of a contest, the parent/guardian must also sign the entry form. All youth competing or taking part in an CWPHC approved event, must be in the care of a responsible adult who is in attendance for the duration of that event, whilst the youth is in attendance at that event.
14. No alcohol is allowed in, nor be consumed in the marshalling areas, working arenas or show pen areas.
15. The committee reserves the right to cancel classes or alter the Program as necessary
16. Exhibitors shall not approach the judge for any reason prior to completion of the judging, unless the exhibitor has finished exhibiting and the request must be made through the Ring Steward. No exhibitor will request information from the Judge, or the decisions made by that Judge, concerning any exhibit at a show, on the day of the show or within the immediate 7 days following the show.
17. Enclosed footwear must be worn at all times in the stabling, wash bay and show areas. This includes any person handling horses.
